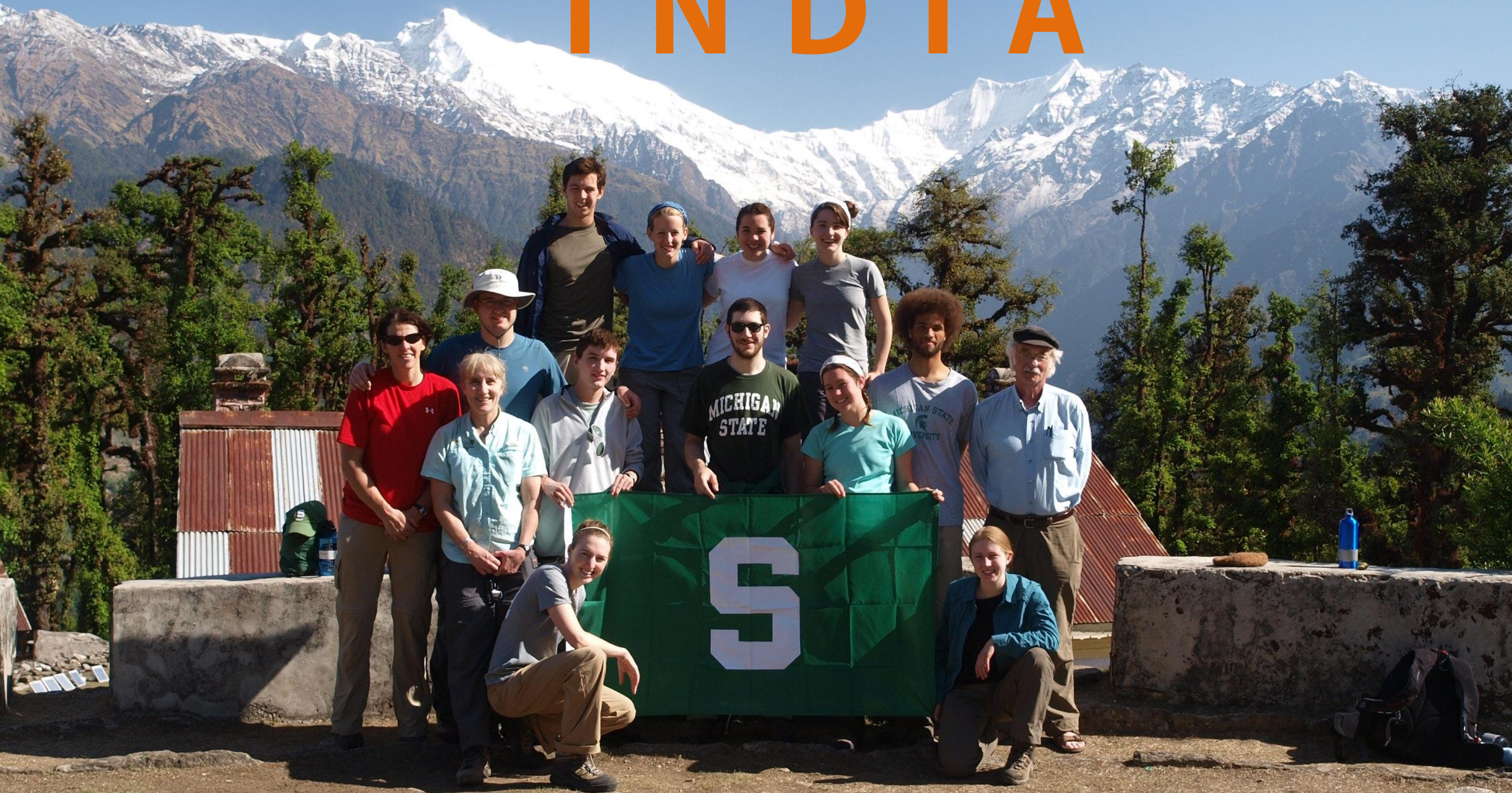


Ecology of the Mountains in INDIA



4 week summer program- Trek through the high Himalayan Range to learn about ecology – their geologic, water, soil, forest and agricultural systems; and ecology of the people – their history, beliefs, cultural expressions and livelihoods. Meet mountain villagers; investigate impacts of environmental, climatic and economic changes; see what strategies may help these people maintain their way of life. Earn 6 credits for a variety of course options, like Integrative Studies in General Science (ISP 217) or Social Science (ISS 310); or more in-depth International Studies, such as Community, Agriculture, Recreation & Resources (ACR 890); Environmental Studies (ESA 475, ESA 480); Tourism, Parks & Recreation (PRR 410); Field Studies in Natural Science (NSC 475) or Social Science (SSC 496).
