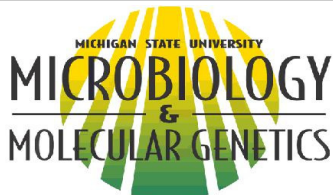
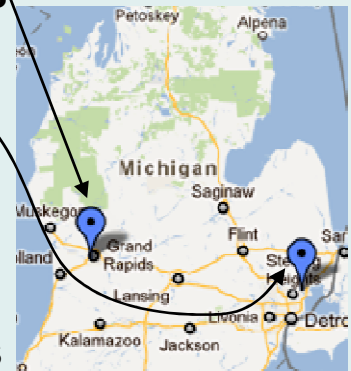
Class includes approx 6 hours/week online work.
